Drug Convictions May Affect Your Financial Aid

By la_w , some students who have drug-related convictions under any federal or state la_w may be ineligible for federal student aid.

According to the $la_{\overline{W}}$, if you are convicted of a drug-related offense you may fact these restrictions:

- 1. For *o on* of illegal drugs, you are ineligible from the date of conviction (not arrest) for:
 - o 1 year for a first offense
 - o 2 years for a second offense
 - o Indefinitely for a third offense
- 2. For of illegal drugs, you are ineligible from the date
