

Drug Convictions May Affect Your Financial Aid

By law, some students who have drug-related convictions under any federal or state law **may be ineligible for federal student aid.**

According to the law, if you are convicted of a drug-related offense you may face these restrictions:

1. For *possession* of illegal drugs, you are ineligible from the date of conviction (not arrest) for:
 - 1 year for a first offense
 - 2 years for a second offense
 - Indefinitely for a third offense
2. For *production* of illegal drugs, you are ineligible from the date

What is an acceptable drug rehabilitation program?

An acceptable drug rehabilitation program must have **TWO** unannounced drug tests **AND** it
